Year 7 Catch up Grant Report 2016-2017

Swanwick School and Sports College

The Year 7 catch up grant is given to any Year 7 students who have performed below national expectations in reading and maths.

In the academic year of 2016/2017 we had 11 pupils on role for year 7. Out of the 11 pupils on role, 11 did not achieve national expectations in reading or maths. Our main focus when utilising the Year 7 catch up money was to increase attainment for our young pupils.

Swanwick School and Sports College was allocated £5,500 Catch up funding for the Year 7 pupils. Below is how we used the funding to improve attainment for our Year 7 students.

- Increased Teaching Assistant hours for specific intervention work.
- All Year 7 students made at least expected progress in reading and maths
